'BHARAT PARVA' AT RED FORT FROM 23.01.2024 TO 31.01.2024.

Ministry of Tourism, Govt. of India is organizing "Bharat Parva" at Red Fort from 23.01.2024 to 31.01.2024. Food Courts and Handicraft Stalls will be installed at 15 August Park and Madhav Das Park for general public. Like previous editions of the Bharat Parv, this edition of the event will showcase the republic day tableaux, performances by the Armed Forces bands, cultural performances by ZCCs and State/UT troupes, a Pan-India Food Court and Crafts bazaar, pavilions of State Governments and Central Ministries etc. The inaugural function of the "Bharat Parv" will be held on 23rd January, 2024 and it will be open to general public till 31st January, 2024. As per the past experience, it is expected that the event will also attract a large number of visitors on all days from 12 Noon to 10 PM. Many VIPs/VVIPs will also visit Red Fort on this occasion.

THE DIVERSION POINTS ARE AS UNDER:

- Chatta Rail Crossing
- Subhash Park T-Point
- Shanti Van Chowk
- Delhi Gate

Traffic will be diverted as per the requirement during the period of the function so that traffic Jam and congestion is avoided.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS:

Traffic restrictions/regulation/diversion may be imposed on following road/stretches and surrounding roads/stretches accordingly where above said function will be organized from 23.01.2024 to 31.01.2024:

- Netaji Subhash Marg from Chatta Rail Chowk to Delhi Gate.
- Nishad Raj Marg from Shanti Van crossing to Subhash Park T-Point.

PARKING:

Many paid parking facilities are available near Red Fort and visitors and general public may use the same as per their need. Below is details of few available parking, distance of venue from parking and suggested routes to reach the parking:

INSTRUCTIONS TO GENERAL PUBLIC:

- General public is advised to avoid above mentioned Roads/Stretches and the area where above said function will be organized.
- The commuters going to New Delhi Railway Station, Old Delhi Railway and ISBT should leave with sufficient time at hand to accommodate possible delays on the route.
- General public is advised to avail public transport facilities especially Metro to reach the venue. Lal Quila, Jama Masjid and Kashmiri Gate are nearest metro stations which can be used to reach Red Fort.
- Park your vehicles only at designated parking lots.
- Avoid roadside parking as it causes hindrance to normal flow traffic.
- In case any unusual/unidentified object or person is noticed in suspicious circumstances, immediately inform nearest police personnel or local police.
- Follow the directions of traffic police personnel deployed to help the visitors.
