### TRAFFIC DIVERSIONS IN CONNECTION WITH TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS OF MILITARY TATTOO & TRIBAL DANCE PROGRAMME AT JAWAHAR LAL NEHRU STADIUM, BHISHAM PITAMAH MARG, NEW DELHI ON 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> OF JANUARY 2023

Information has been received that Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India has been organizing a Military Tattoo & Tribal Dance as part of the Republic Day celebrations during the 75<sup>th</sup> year of Independence at Jawahar Lal Nehru Stadium on 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of January 2023. About 50,000 people are expected to witness the programme. Keeping in view the fact that a large number of spectators including various civil and military VVIPs/VIPs and dignitaries apart from full capacity public audience will be arriving at Jawahar Lal Nehru Stadium to watch the programme, certain traffic restrictions are being proposed at and around Jawahar Lal Nehru Stadium with a view to ensure smooth flow of traffic and ease of movement for the spectators.

### INSTRUCTIONS TO GENERAL PUBLIC:-

- Park only at designated places
- Use public transport to reach the venue
- Plan your journey to reach Hospitals, ISBTs, Railway stations or airport well in advance



### TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS/DIVERSION:-

The corridors which are going to be affected due to the restrictions on the days of programme are as under:-

1. Bhisam Pitamah Marg from Lodhi Road to Andrews Ganj Flyover
2. Lodhi Road
3. Max Muller Marg
4. Maharishi Raman Marg
5. Arch Bishop Marg
6. Subramaniam Bharti Marg
7. Lala Lajpat Rai Marg

### COMMUTERS ARE ADVISED TO PLAN THEIR JOURNEY ACCORDINGLY ON BELOW MENTIONED ROAD/STRETCHS:-

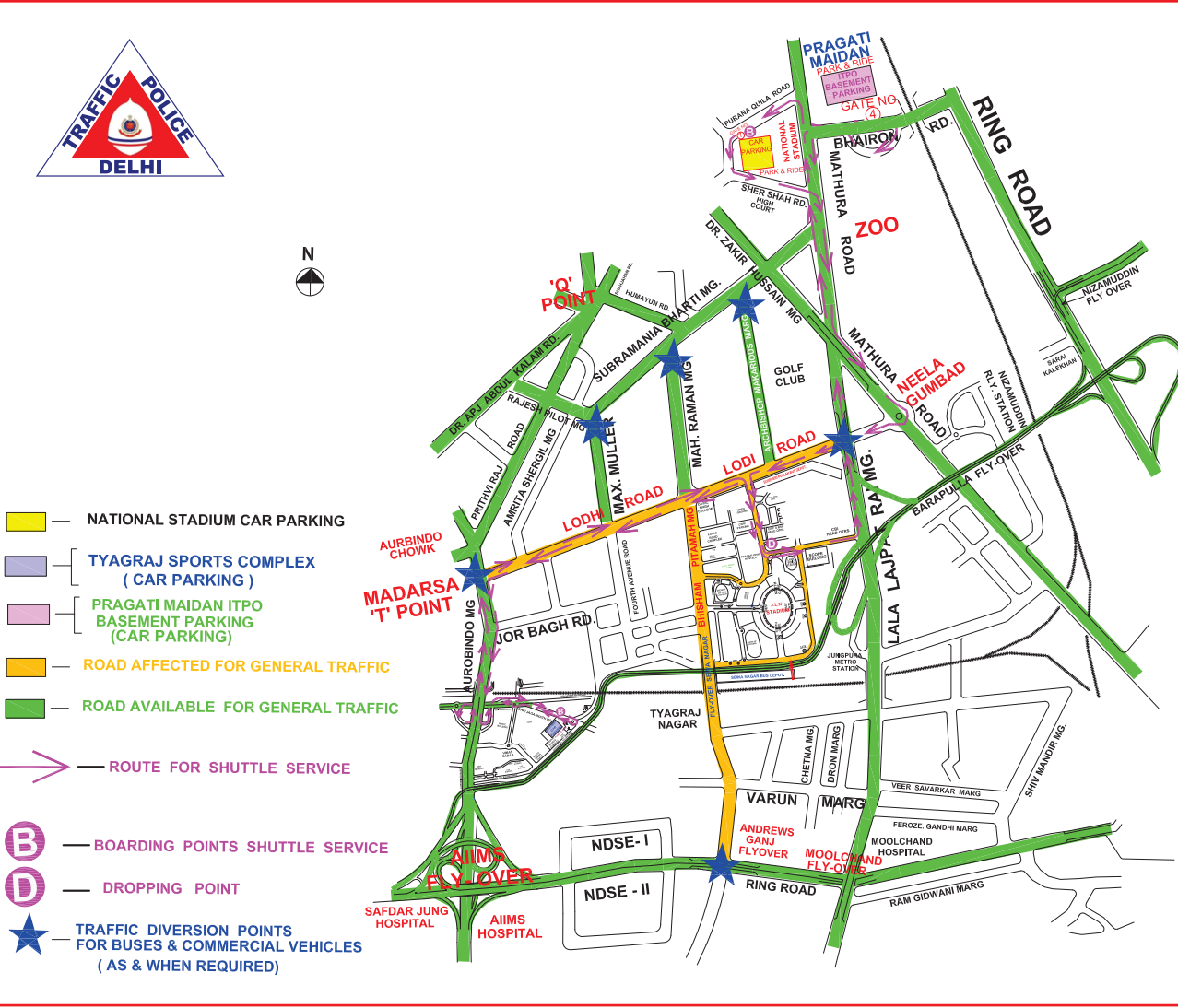
In view of the restrictions, the commuters are advised to avoid the above stretches/corridors between 1100 to 2100 hrs on 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> January-2023. Therefore, the commuters are advised to follow the following corridors to reach their destinations:-

S.No.	Name of Diversion Point	Remarks
1.	Traffic Signal Andrews Ganj intersection (for Buses & commercial vehicles)	No heavy vehicles (Buses & commercial vehicles) will be allowed on Bhisam Pitamah Marg. These vehicles are advised to go straight on Ring Road and take Lala Lajpat Rai Marg or Aurobindo Marg from AIIMS Flyover to go towards New Delhi area.
2.	Maharishi Raman Marg – Subramaniam Bharti Marg Crossing	No heavy vehicles/commercial vehicles including buses will be allowed on Lodhi Road from Maharishi Raman Marg. The commuters are advised to follow Subramaniam Bharti Marg and Dr Zakir Hussain Marg, R/A Neela Gumbad to go towards Lajpat Nagar, AIIMS, Ring Road.
3.	Max Muller Marg – Subramaniam Bharti Marg Crossing	No heavy vehicles/commercial vehicles including buses will be allowed on Lodhi Road from Maharishi Raman Marg. The commuters are advised to follow Subramaniam Bharti Marg and Dr Zakir Hussain Marg, R/A Neela Gumbad to go towards Lajpat Nagar, AIIMS, Ring Road.
4.	Arch Bishop Marg – Subramaniam Bharti Marg Crossing	No heavy vehicles/commercial vehicles including buses will be allowed on Lodhi Road from Maharishi Raman Marg. The commuters are advised to follow Subramaniam Bharti Marg and Dr Zakir Hussain Marg, R/A Neela Gumbad to go towards Lajpat Nagar, AIIMS, Ring Road.
5.	Under Lodhi Road Flyover	No heavy vehicle (Buses & Commercial Vehicles) will be allowed towards Lodhi Road. Commuters coming from New Delhi side are advised to follow Lala Lajpat Rai Marg to go Lajpat Nagar, INA, AIIMS, Ring Road. Commuters coming from Moolchand Hospital Flyover side are advised to follow Mathura Road via Neela Gumbad to go towards New Delhi.
6.	Madrasa T–Point, Lodhi Road–Aurobindo Marg Crossing	No heavy vehicle (Buses & Commercial Vehicles) will be allowed towards Lodhi Road and Jawahar Lal Nehru Stadium. Commuters coming from New Delhi and South Delhi are advised to follow Prithvi Raj Road and Subramaniam Bharti Marg to go towards Nizamuddin and Mathura Road.

The spectators and commuters including those working in the offices at SCOPE Complex, CGO Complex and adjoining areas are advised to use public transport on 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> January-2023 as the Jawahar Lal Nehru Stadium has its own Metro Station on Violet Line – from Kashmere Gate to Escort Mujesar which is connected with other lines on Kashmere Gate, Mandi House & Central Secretariat inter-change Metro Stations.

### PARK & RIDE:-

Apart from the Delhi Metro, the spectators are advised to use the 'Park & Ride' Scheme for the Military Tattoo & Tribal Dance programme from Pragati Maidan (Bhairon Marg), National Stadium and Thyagraj Stadium. The spectators can park their vehicles at I.T.P.O. Parking at Pragati Maidan (Bhairon Marg), National Stadium and Thyagraj Stadium and board free DTC shuttle bus service to reach Jawahar Lal Nehru Stadium.
