SAFE TWO-WHEELER TRAINING PROGRAMME BY DELHI TRAFFIC POLICE

The concept of free safe two-wheeler riding training especially for women, the first of its kind in India, was launched by Delhi Traffic Police in association with Honda Motorcycle and Scooter India (HMSI) Ltd. at TT Park, Roshnara Bagh on 20th July 2013. On the occasion of the first anniversary celebrations of this joint venture initiative by Delhi Traffic Police and HMSI on 19th July 2014, Jt. C.P./ Traffic launched a new E-Mail Id dreamriding@ttpdelhi.in so as to enable easy enrollment for safe riding training at TT Park, Roshanara Bagh, by women from their homes. We received overwhelming response on this e-mail ID with thousands of college girls, working women and housewives getting themselves enrolled for the said training programme.

On 24th November 2014, safe two-wheeler riding training was introduced in the Traffic Training Park of Delhi Traffic Police at Baba Kharak Singh Park in association with Honda Motorcycle and Scooter India (HMSI) Ltd.

Since then, every day 100 girls/women each (in TT Park Roshanara Bagh & Baba Kharak Singh Marg) are being imparted training in safe two-wheeler riding which includes training on simulator, cycling to enhance their balancing skills and finally practical training on two-wheeler. The four-hour long thorough training programme has not only made them skilled two-wheeler riders but also enhanced their confidence on roads.

More and more girls/women who have been dreaming or dreamt of learning two-wheeler riding and becoming an independent rider can get themselves enrolled at dreamriding@ttpdelhi.in and make their dreams turn into reality.
