**Green Corridor for transportation of critically ill patient for brain surgery**

In yet another incident of dedication to the service of citizens, Delhi Traffic Police contributed in its own way in saving the life of a man by providing the **Green Corridor** to an Ambulance carrying a critically ill patient for brain surgery from Domestic Airport Terminal-1D to Medanta Hospital, Gurgaon.

On 11.02.2016, a request was made to Delhi Traffic Police to provide Green Corridor for the Ambulance of a critically ill patient needing immediate brain surgery from Domestic Airport Terminal-1D to Medanta Hospital, Gurgaon. In the evening peak hours when the traffic is chock-a-block, reaching hospital without losing the precious time was a big challenge. After getting the information Delhi Traffic Police immediately brought the traffic personnel into swift action and additional traffic personnel were deployed on the corridor from Airport Terminal-1D to Medanta Hospital, Gurgaon (upto Rajokari Border). Ambulance carrying the patient alongwith the team of doctors left the Airport Terminal-ID hospital at about 04:37 PM and reached Rajokari Border at about 04:46 PM. A distance of 10.5 Km was covered in just 9 minutes.

Delhi Traffic Police once again rose to the occasion and executed the seamless movement of the Ambulance. We are happy to contribute in the noble cause of saving a life.
