Dedicated to the service of citizens, Delhi Traffic Police contributed in its own way in saving the life of a man by providing the green corridor to an Ambulance carrying a heart to be transplanted.

A person was declared brain dead at Fortis Hospital, Gurgaon and his family consented to donate the organs. Fortis Escort Hospital New Friends Colony, Delhi had a patient who required heart transplant. The hospital authorities decided to transport the live organ from Gurgaon to Delhi hospital. After getting information, Delhi Traffic Police decided the route and deployed its officers to facilitate the seam less flow of ambulance from Fortis Hospital Gurgaon to Fortis Escort Hospital New Friends Colony, Delhi. The ambulance carrying live organ entered Delhi at 0200 hrs. on 5.2.2016 and covered a distance of 25 KM from Aya Nagar to New Friends Colony via Andheria More, MB Road, Khanpur, BRT Corridor, Chirag Delhi, Outer Ring Road, Modi Mill Fly Over in about 17 mins. Traffic police also video recorded the movement, especially those vehicles who did not leave the right lane for smooth movement of ambulance despite directions to keep away. Based on these evidences, violators will be prosecuted by sending the challans at their addresses.
