PRESS RELEASE

The Eastern Peripheral Expressway will become operational from 27.05.2018 for general public. All non-Delhi destined goods vehicles approaching from Gurugram, Faridabad, Noida and Ghaziabad will be diverted onto the Eastern Peripheral Expressway before entering Delhi. These diversions will be enforced from 0700 hrs on 27.05.2018 onwards. There will be an additional deployment of police personnel at all border entry points connecting Delhi with the neighbouring districts on Eastern Peripheral Expressway to divert non-Delhi destined goods vehicles from entering into Delhi. The neighbouring districts of Uttar Pradesh and Haryana will also deploy adequate number of police personnel at the diversion points near the expressway for the diversions. Such non-Delhi destined goods vehicles found plying in Delhi will be prosecuted as per law. Therefore all transporters' associations and transporters are advised to use the Eastern Peripheral Expressway to bypass Delhi for non-Delhi destined goods vehicles.
