In its continuous efforts to serve better the officers of Traffic Unit of Delhi Police have done it again by creating a Special Green Corridor to save the life of a patient admitted in ILBS Hospital, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi. The patient was suffering from a **lever disease** and a lever transplant was required.

On 24th August, 2018, a lever was transported from PGI, Chandigarh to New Delhi through a Jet Airways flight at Terminal T-3. In a well planned and coordinated move by the Traffic Police - TI/IGI Airport, TI/Palam Airport and TI/Vasant Vihar - a green corridor was provided on a route of 12 KM to take the organ from IGI Airport-T-3 to ILBS Hospital, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi. The distance could be covered in just 13 minutes (from 1758 hours to 1811 hours), which would have taken more than 30 minutes in a regular course.

A lever needs to be replanted into the recipient within 04 hours of its retrieval from the donor. By virtue of the sincere and coordinated efforts, the same could successfully be done within the stipulated time.
