In its continuous efforts to serve better the officers of Traffic Unit of Delhi Police have done it again by creating a Special Green Corridor to save the life of a patient admitted in RR Hospital, Delhi Cantt., New Delhi. The patient was suffering from a liver disease and a liver transplant was required.

On 25th August, 2018, a liver was transported from Dehradun Hospital to New Delhi through an AFS Dornier Jet Flight at AFS Palam Airport. In a well planned and coordinated move by the Traffic Police - TI/Palam Airport and TI/Delhi Cantt. - a green corridor was provided on a route of 5.50 KM to take the Organ from AFS Palam Airport to RR Hospital, Delhi Cantt., New Delhi. The distance was covered in just 5.37 minutes (from 07.59 hours to 08.05 hours), which would have taken more than 30 minutes regular course.

A liver needs to be replanted into the recipient within 04 hours of its retrieval from the donor. By virtue of the sincere and coordinated efforts, the same could successfully be done within the stipulated time.
