In its endeavour to reach out to the general public and serve better, the Traffic Unit of Delhi Police provided two "Special Green Corridor" in a single day i.e. 28.11.2018.

In the first case, a 55 year old woman suffering from severe Cardio-Neuro disorder landed at Terminal–1 from Bareilly and was immediately shifted to AIIMS. The convoy of vehicles started from Terminal-1 at 1246 hours and reached AIIMS in just 22 minutes after covering a distance of about 12 kms, whereas the routine travel time from Tereminal-1 to AIIMS during this time slot would have been around one hour.

In another case, a 75 year old man who suffered multiple Heart Attacks was flown from Calcutta to Terminal – 3 Delhi. The patient was immediately rushed to Escort Fortis Hospital, Sukhdev Vihar. The Carcade of patient started from T-3 at 1:55 PM and reached Escort Fortis Hospital at 2:25 PM. The 22 kms distance between Escort Fortis Hospital and Terminal-3 was covered in just 30 minutes without disturbing the regular traffic on the road. The normal travel time on this route during the peak hour traffic is around 1 to $1\frac{1}{2}$ hour.
