On getting suspicious they immediately stopped checking and rushed to the cries and found that an abandoned newly born baby girl in the bushes.

Immediately Delhi Police Control Room was informed and the infant was rushed to Safdarjung Hospital for immediate medical attention. The baby is doing fine now. In this regard a case vide FIR No. 285/18 u/s 317 IPC was also got registered in Safdarjung Police Station. The Traffic Police staff is being suitably rewarded.
