Commendable Work done by Traffic Staff of Nangloi Circle – Recovery of Stolen Vehicle and Detection of Two Snatching & One Theft Cases

The Traffic Police staff of Nangloi Circle have demonstrated

exceptional professionalism, alertness and compassion while performing their duty, resulting in the recovery of a stolen motorcycle and the workout of two snatching and one theft cases. On 05.10.2025 at about 2.15 PM, the traffic staff of Nangloi Circle, comprising ASI Sandeep No. 685/T (ZO), HC Ravikant No. 3533/T, HC Sumit No. 5019/T, HC Ravinder No. 3720/T and Ct. Rakesh No. 3082/T, were performing traffic regulation and prosecution duty at Khanda Chowk, Meera Bagh, Nilothi, Delhi.

During checking, a motorcycle bearing registration No. DL-6SBA-0585 (KTM 390 Duke) was stopped as the rider was not wearing a helmet and the pillion rider (a lady) was also without a helmet. During verification, the rider suddenly fled from the spot, leaving behind the motorcycle and the pillion rider.

Upon verification, the said motorcycle was found to be stolen vide FIR No. 027487/25 dated 05.10.2025, PS Punjabi Bagh. The lady and the recovered motorcycle were immediately handed over to the local police of PS Ranhola for further action.

During subsequent enquiry, it was revealed that the said motorcycle and the persons involved were also connected with two snatching cases registered at PS Ranhola and PS Nihal Vihar.

The above staff of Nangloi Circle have displayed alertness, dedication and high sense of duty while performing their official tasks. Their timely action not only led to the recovery of a stolen vehicle but also assisted in the workout of 03 criminal cases.

In recognition of their outstanding work, the above-mentioned team members are being suitably rewarded for their excellent performance.
